Conditions (TCC)

1. Purpose. To provide in detail MCCS activities which will remain open and those that will close as the various tropical cyclone conditions are set.

2. Cancellation. MCCSO 1746.9C

3. Procedures

a. The Command will initiate the Destructive Weather Frost Call and all MCCS activities will respond as indicated in the enclosure.

b. All personnel shall check with their supervisor prior to leaving their activities. Certain activities shall remain open and essential personnel will be identified by departments to remain working.

SPECIFIC TASKS OF MCCS ACTIVITIES BY TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITION

TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITION V (TCC V)

The potential for the occurrence of destructive weather is elevated but no specific system threatens the area. TCC V indicates a seasonal destructive weather readiness level, i.e., Atlantic Hurricane Season (1 June - 30 November) is in progress or that a specific forecast to affect the area within 96 hours.

TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITION IV (TCC IV) (72 Hours)

Begin progressive actions toward preparing facilities and personnel against the effects of destructive weather. However, all MCCS activities will remain open without substantial operational or service interruption. MCCS Cherry Point employee weather hotline and MCCS Cherry Point website will be updated regularly to reflect changes in TCC.

TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITION III (TCC III) (48 Hours)

Be prepared to secure marinas, golf course, pools, recreational areas and campgrounds. Furthermore, be prepared to provide MCCS equipment and personnel to support emergency shelters and other operations as required.

TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITION II (TCC II) (24 Hours)

Provide the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) with timetable for closure and hours of operation of MCCS activities to remain open.

TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITION I (TCC I) (12 Hours)

Secure all non-essential MCCS activities, facilities, and services to include the Main Exchange and Child Development Center. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the MCCS Director for specific fitness centers, Single Marine Program Facility, theater and convenience stores.

TROPICAL CYCLONE CONDITON I (C) CAUTION (TCC I (C)) (6 Hours)

Close remaining MCCS activities, facilities and services. All MCCS activities, facilities and services will remain closed through TCC I (E) Emergency.

DESTRUCTIVE WEATHER CONDITON IR (RECOVERY)

The Convenience Stores and Single Marine Program Facility (The Roadhouse) will reopen as soon as practical during IR.

**\*Note:** Upon sounding "ALL CLEAR" all MCCS activities will resume full operation and normal business hours.
